## WOLFEBORO TO HOST MAY MEETING

Chief Philip "Butch" Morrill of Wolfeboro Fire-Rescue will host the May meeting of the NHAFC on Thursday, May 10, 2007. The day will begin with golf at the Kingswood Golf Club for those interested. Reserve a tee time by calling the Kingswood Golf Club pro at 569-3569. The KGC is located at 24 Kingswood Rd in Wolfeboro.

Professional development is set to start at 4pm at the Barn-door Restaurant, 29 Allen Rd. The topic is scheduled to be a representative of the Drug Enforcement Administration speaking about meth labs and marijuana farms.

Social hour begins at 5pm at the Barndoor. A buffet dinner starts at 6pm. Dinner is \$25 pp. Please send a check made out to the NHAFC to Chief Butch Morrill, Wolfeboro Fire-Rescue, PO Box 629, Wolfeboro, NH 03894 by Friday, May 4, 2007.

**Directions:** From the South...take Route 28 North from the Epsom Circle. Follow Route 28 through the Alton Circle and into Wolfeboro. Pass Kingswood Regional High School on your right. Kingswood Road (for golf) is less than a quarter-mile beyond the high school on the left. Continue into town ½ mile past the Public Safety Building. Take a right onto Center Street/Route 28 north. Follow Route 28 north for approx. 2.5 miles. Allen Road is on your left...if you pass it you can access the Barndoor from Center St.

From the Seacoast...take the Spaulding Turnpike to the Route 11 exit. Follow Route 11 to the Alton Traffic Circle. See above.

From the North...take Route 16 south to the intersection of Route 28 in Ossipee. Take Route 28 south into Wolfeboro. Continue about ½ mile past the 7-11. You will see the Barndoor on your right.

From the West...Take Route 104 into Meredith. Left at the lights on Route 3. Follow into downtown. Take a right onto Route 25 east. Follow into Moultonborough and take a right onto Route 109. Follow Route 109 into Wolfeboro. Pass through downtown, take a left onto Center St/Route 28 north at the Citgo station. Follow Route 28 north for approx. 2.5 miles. Allen Road is on your left...if you pass it you can access the Barndoor from Center St.
