

STATEWIDE FIRE MOBILIZATION PLAN 2010 REVISION

The New Hampshire Association of Fire Chiefs has contracted with the New Hampshire Department of Safety, Bureau of Fire Safety to review and revise the **New Hampshire Statewide Fire Mobilization Plan**. The association has acquired the services of Chief Thomas Lambert (Ret.) to facilitate this revision. The Association is working closely with the New Hampshire State Fire Marshal, New Hampshire Department of Homeland Security, Federation of Fire Mutual Aid Associations of New Hampshire and the International Association of Fire Chiefs to produce a plan that is ideally suited to provide emergency response to the communities of New Hampshire in Emergency Response to incident that are beyond the capabilities of the local and regional response agencies.

This project requires the review of New Hampshire State laws and administrative rules as well as a comparison to the plans, rules and laws of neighboring States. The project will require input from the fire service through Workshops that will be conducted throughout the State as well as guidance from major communications facilities in an effort to streamline the dispatch methodology.

The Association will work with all stakeholders to plan tabletop and real time exercises to train personnel in plan mobilization as well as review the effectiveness and efficiency of the plan.
